Declaration of Faith

- 1. We believe the Eternal God, the creator of heaven and earth is the One True and Living God.
- 2. We believe in the three Persons of the Godhead. Which constitutes the Holy Trinity in the persons of The Father, The Son, and The Holy Ghost all operating in one.
- 3. We believe in the Virgin Birth of Jesus Christ.
- 4. We believe in the Dichotomy of Jesus Christ, meaning He was both God and man, human and Divine.
- 5. We believe Jesus Christ is the only way to Salvation.
- 6. We believe in the death, burial, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus Christ.
- 7. We believe in Sacraments instituted by Jesus Christ. Precisely, Baptism, Eucharist, and Feet Washing.
- 8. We believe the preaching and teaching of Jesus Christ supersede any and all other preaching and teaching and is the authority of Scripture in the Plan of Salvation.
- 9. We believe in and pray the prayer taught by Jesus Christ with all the understanding that the seven petitions cover the entire need of man known or unknown.
- 10. We believe in the resurrection of the dead and the return of Jesus Christ which demonstrates, confirms, and verifies life after death.
- 11. We believe in the Creation of man from the dust of the ground and the Creation substantiates that all men are both free and equal.
- 12. We believe there is One Family; The Human Family
- 13. We believe in the inerrancy and the infallibility of the Bible, which composites the Plan of Salvation from Genesis to Revelation constituting both Old and New Testaments in which God is the author.
